April Fools Day March on Albany, in Opposition to the NYSAFE Act

SCOPE is promoting a rally for our rights on April 1, 2014, in Albany.

The Onondaga County Federation Of Sportsmens Club, in cooperation with the Oswego County Federation of Sportsmens Club, has chartered two (2) buses from our area.

Bus Number One (1) will LEAVE the Pulaski Tractor Supply Co. (TSC) store at 5:45 AM. This store is on State Route 13. People boarding this bus need to park at the end of the lot near the H+R Block offices and make sure that your vehicles are NOT blocking the hitching rails for TSC's Amish customers and NOT blocking the gate that accesses TSC's outdoor equipment yard. This bus will proceed to the Cicero Gander Mountain store.

Bus Number Two (2) will LEAVE the Cicero Gander Mountain store lot at 6:30 AM, along with Bus Number One. Parking for riders of Bus Number South end of the parking lot. This is the end of the Gander Mtn. building farthest from the entrance to the lot, off of Carmenica Drive.

Dress code is business casual, or better. NO blue jeans and camo, please. Signs for the rally may not be allowed inside the legislative buildings.

SUMMER TRAP LEAGUE: B'ville is a member of the Tri-County Trap League which is made up of 5-6 clubs that shoot on Wednesday night from around mid-April until early August. It is a travel league and is fun to shoot at the other clubs. Each club usually hosts the league three times during the league season. The official sign-in time is 5:00pm to 8:00pm, but most clubs start shooting around 4:00pm. Last year it cost \$15 to join the league and the weekly fee to shoot was \$5.00.

The top six scores from each team are used each week, so even if you are not a great shooter don't be afraid to join. It is not like a bowling league where you need to get a substitute, so come when your schedule allows and you only pay when you shoot.

- 2) Phone #, preferably cell

- 4) which bus they will board (Pulaski or Gander Mtn).
