



Covid-19 Reopening

In mid-March 2020 we were forced to limit shooting activities at the club due to the Covid-19 pandemic. Rifle, pistol, and archery were allowed to continue with members required to observe social distancing. Shotgun sports were suspended, meetings and events canceled, and the clubhouse was closed. On June 3, 2020, the Officers and Directors allowed a limited reopening according to our published and posted plan. That plan is posted at the club and is available on our website. To protect the health of our members, the clubhouse remains closed. Please use social distancing when shooting on our outdoor ranges. Thank you for being smart to stay healthy.

Monthly Meetings and Memberships

Club meetings are held on the first Thursday of every month at 7:00 pm at the clubhouse on Kingdom Road. All members are welcome! Memberships are available at the club at our monthly meeting or on the first and third Saturday mornings from 10:00am to 2:00pm. If you are a current member and wish to renew by mail, please download the renewal application form off the website and mail it in with your payment. A new membership card and the gate combination will be mailed to you.

Shooting Sports

The rifle/pistol/archery range is open 7 days a week unless a special event is scheduled. On Saturdays Trap, Skeet, and 5-Stand Sporting Clays start at 9am and are done around 1:00pm. On Wednesdays the Trap and Skeet fields are open at 1:00pm. Trap and skeet are \$4 per round, and Sporting Clays is \$5

Weekly trap practice on Monday at 5:30pm and Sporting Clays on Thursday at 4pm. These will continue through September weather permitting.

Baldwinsville will not be shooting in the Wednesday Tri-County Trap League. This year's League was canceled due to Covid-19.

Shotgun Championship

Our annual club shotgun championship is on Saturday, September 5th this year, so please save the date. The winner is the highest scoring total from a round of Trap, Skeet, and Sporting clays.
