

RANGE RULES

SHOOTING HOURS:

Monday – Saturday: 8am Until 15 Minutes Before Sunset

Sunday: 10am Until 15 Minutes Before Sunset

SHOOTING AFTER SUNSET IS NOT PERMITTED

- ⊙ Anyone On The Firing Line Must Wear Eye And Ear Protection.
- ⊙ When Going Downrange, All Shooters Must:
 1. Declare And Ensure A Cease Fire.
 2. Firearms **MUST** Be Unloaded With Actions Open And Not Handled.
 3. Safety Lights **MUST** Be Turned On When Forward Of The Firing Line.
- ⊙ Each Shooter Must Provide Their Own Targets.
- ⊙ Do Not Damage Club Structures Or Target Posts.
- ⊙ Shoot All Targets Straight-On. Use Right-Most Benches When Shooting At 100-Yard And 200-Yard Targets.
- ⊙ Members May Bring One Guest. Member Is Responsible For Guest's Conduct.
- ⊙ Must Be Age 12+ To Shoot. Children 12-16 Must Be Accompanied By An Adult.
- ⊙ Members Are Required To Produce Club-Issued Identification On Request.
- ⊙ Range Officers Have Authority To Enforce All Range Rules.

PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES

- ⊙ NO SHOOTING OF OBJECTS PLACED ON GROUND. ALL TARGETS MUST BE SUSPENDED 3 FEET ABOVE THE GROUND.
- ⊙ NO SHOOTING OF HUMAN SILHOUETTE TARGETS.
- ⊙ NO SHOOTING OF GLASS, METAL, OR PLASTIC CONTAINERS.
- ⊙ NO BUCKSHOT OR BIRDSHOT ON THE ORANGE NETS.
- ⊙ NO SHOOTING TREES, CLUB STRUCTURES, OR TARGET FRAMES/POSTS.
- ⊙ NO FIREARM IS TO BE DISCHARGED ABOVE HORIZONTAL.
- ⊙ NO DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS AT A RAPID RATE (1 SHOT IN 2 SECONDS).
- ⊙ NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE OR ILLEGAL DRUGS ARE PERMITTED ON THE RANGES.
- ⊙ NO SHOOTING AT METAL REACTIVE TARGETS ON THE 15 YARD RANGE WITH MAGNUM OR RIFLE CARTRIDGES.

STEEL TARGET RULES

GENERAL RULES

- No Targets On Wooden Structures
- Shoot Straight-On

15 YARD

- Pistol Calibers Only, No Magnum
- Eye Protection Is Mandatory For Shooters AND Spectators

50 YARD

- .22LR ONLY! No .22WMR, .17HMR, 9mm, etc.

100/200 YARD

- No Steel Tip or Steel Core!
- Impact Velocity Over 3,000 Feet Per Second Will Damage Targets

ARCHERY RANGE RULES

GENERAL RULES

- Eye Protection Is Recommended At All Times
- No Firearms On Archery Range, Including BB Guns Or Pellet Guns
- Field Tips Only, No Broadheads
- Safety Harnesses Should Be Used On The Upper Platform
- Do Not Move The Targets
- Do Not Leave Your Personal Targets On The Range.

Orientation Overview

- ⦿ Keep firearms pointed downrange AT ALL TIMES, especially when moving between shooting stations.
 - ⦿ First aid kits are inside the clubhouse and in the archery barn. Email us if supplies are used so that we may restock them.
 - ⦿ Eye and ear protection are required at all times for all shooters and spectators.
 - ⦿ In order to cross the firing line, all firearms must be unloaded with actions open and no firearms may be handled while anyone is downrange. The safety lights must also be turned on, no exceptions.
 - ⦿ Members are required to coordinate a cease-fire with other shooters. Ensure that all shooters have returned and equipped their eye and ear protection before turning the safety lights off.
 - ⦿ The premises are under video surveillance, but we do depend on members to report anything that could be unsafe, rule violations, or in need of repair.
 - ⦿ The EPA Lead Report must be filled out after shooting.
 - ⦿ The archery barn contains many items that you are welcome to use, but please replace anything removed and help keep the barn organized.
 - ⦿ Trap, Skeet, and Five Stand/Sporting Clays are run on Saturdays between 10am and 1pm, and as noted on the club website calendar. To shoot, approach the counter and pay the \$4 or \$5 fee.
 - ⦿ All members are subject to the club by-laws which can be found on our website.
